## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands in Reading from 38% to 45% for Year 3 students by 2015.
- Develop a learning plan for students who are below the National Minimum Standard in Reading and Number.
- Improve teacher capability through focused coaching and extended professional development to improve student performance.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands in Numeracy from 20% to 30% for Year 3 students by 2015.

## Our strategy will be to

- Review school performance each term.
- Review student performance at least twice each term.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Build teacher (and teacher aide) capability in teaching practice by employing a 0.6 Pedagogy Coach/ Professional Developer.	\$70 000
• Build teacher capability in teaching practice by supporting Professional Learning Teams and extended Professional Development.	\$50 000
• Lift student achievement by engaging specialist educators to coach individual and small groups of students before school and during school time.	\$70 000
• Lift early literacy for young children by creating Parent Engagement and Pre-Prep programs in conjunction with families.	\$10 000
• Improve early literacy for Prep and Year 1 children in need through a quality oral language program.	\$30 298
