

# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2019  
Coomera State School will receive

**\$338,384\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students who achieve at a C level or higher in **English** to >80% and at a B level of higher in **English** to 50% in 2019
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands in **Writing** to 40% for Year 3 and 30% for Year 5 in 2019.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands in **Reading** to 56% for Year 3 and 45% for Year 5 in 2019.
- Reduce the average **daily major behaviour incidents** from 6.31 to 4.00 in 2019.
- Increase the **average attendance** from 92.5 to 92.6 in 2019.
- Increase the percentage of **students attending more than 85% of days** to 90.5% in 2019.

  - Embed school-wide weekly behaviour lessons

| • Employ three teacher leaders of learning to build teacher capacity in the teaching of writing in all learning context.  | \$135,000 |
| • Extending the employment of a leader of engagement and student support aide to extend the implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning at the school.                              | \$125,000 |
| • Employ additional specialist teachers to enable teaching teams to operate as professional learning teams to discuss learning.   | \$45,000  |
| • Provide release time for teacher curriculum representatives to further refine and lead curriculum development.  | \$5,500   |
| • Provide replacement teachers to enable teachers to engage in collegial observation and feedback, performance meetings and time for professional learning within their performance plan. | \$20,000  |
| • Provide capacity for short term intervention programs with students to create a sustained improvement in engagement and learning.   | \$7,884   |
